Accommodation	The rent for a cell apartment with one room, a shared kitchen and a bathroom varies between 170 € and 310 € per month. The deposit of 250 € has to be paid before the incoming international students arrive in Finland.
Study material	A student may have to acquire study material and in that case has to cover the costs.
Food	Approximately 2,60 €/meal at the student cafeteria



City transportation	A single ticket costs 3 €. Students can buy student priced travel cards: e.g. 10 trips cost about 20 € and is valid for 12 months, ticket for 30 days costs about 50 €
