

Study Abroad and Internship Program for European and Korean Students (SAIPEKS)



To prepare students for success in the global workplace, the SAIPEKS project will offer 63 European and 51 Korean students the chance to combine overseas study with an internship during the regular semester for full academic credit. Each host university will also provide a specially designed course to help students understand the workplace culture of their host nation, including international team-teaching activities by visiting staff from each partner institution. All participating students will receive a generous monthly stipend and travel grant.

Daegu is the third largest city in Korea with a population of approximately 2.5 million, and conveniently located in relation to Seoul (less than 2 hours by bullet train) and Busan (1 hour). An education and cultural city with strong historical links, Daegu is also known as the "Green and Fashion City" and a key center for regional industrial development. The main electronics plants for LG and Samsung, and the ancient capital city of Gyeongju are all within 40 minutes driving of Daegu.

In August 2003, Daegu hosted the 22nd Summer Universiade Games that attracted over 7,000 participants from 172 countries. Plus, Daegu has been selected to host the World Athletics Championships in 2011, providing another wonderful opportunity to build the international profile of the city.

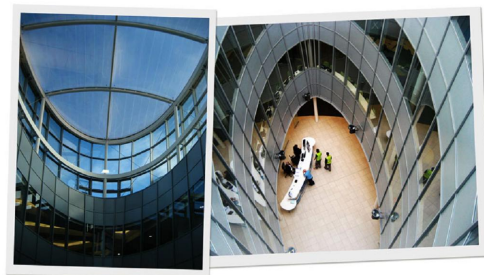
