"A Tale of Three Studies: Driving Customer Service, Dead Career Walking, and Effects of a Hostile Work Environment"

"Professor Alan Witt will be presenting an overview of his current research program, focusing on three studies. The first study, "Driving Customer Service," examines the roles of store-level service climate and internal service on customer ratings of service quality and satisfaction with service. The second, "Dead Career Walking," investigates personality and contextual effects on supervisor-ratings of employee team-player behavior. The third, "Effects of a Hostile Work Environment," examines how the joint effects of two personality traits – conscientiousness and emotional stability – affect stress reactions to a hostile work environment."
