Perceived change turbulence and change readiness: learning from entrepreneurial cognition

The purpose of our study is to better understand the concept of individual change readiness. We seek the answer to achieving change readiness by turning to entrepreneurs and focusing on the neglected aspect of change context. Entrepreneurs are individuals who need to be change-ready and master change well to thrive in contemporary fast-changing environments. We combine the literatures on entrepreneurship, change management, and psychology in search of better understanding individuals' change readiness. The results from regression analysis show support for our hypothesis that perceived change turbulence (context of the change) is a predictor of an individual's change readiness.
